



40 Days with Jesus: The Challenge of Unbelief
John 7:45-52, Matt. 21:15-17, Matt. 26: 57-68

Main Idea: When we question anything, Jesus is the answer!

Connect: Where would you go if you were invisible?

Discuss

1. What insight, observation, or principal from this sermon did you find to be most helpful, insightful or troubling? Explain ...
2. Do we hear Him? (John 7: 45-52)
 - a. As Christians we have the ability to receive a great deal of information about Christ, but how much are we *really hearing*? How does Jesus speak the most clearly to you?
 - b. What hinders your ability to really hear what Jesus is saying?
3. Does Jesus hear us? (Matt. 21:15-17)
 - a. What tools are available to us that can enhance our prayer life? Are you using them to their full extent?
 - b. How can we evaluate the condition of our hearts?
4. Can Jesus be trusted? (Matt. 26:57-68)
 - a. What proof has Jesus given you about who He is? Are you truly relying upon it in your everyday life?
 - b. How would you define your relationship with Christ? Who do you say He is? Does your daily life reflect this?

Live it Out

There is a difference in experiencing life using our physical senses versus our spiritual perspective. This week ask God to heighten your spiritual acuity. Allow the Holy Spirit to open your spiritual eyes and ears to His work.

Open you heart and allow Jesus to teach you how to praise him. When you ask him, do not bring a preconceived idea of what this would look like for you, and do not hesitate when the opportunity comes. (Don't worry. He will not embarrass you.)
