1. Definition

A near-death experience (NDE) is a personal experience associated with impending death, encompassing multiple possible sensations including detachment from the body, feelings of levitation, total serenity, security, warmth, the experience of absolute dissolution, and the presence of a light.

3. What the Bible describes is a PDE (pre-death experience) or NDA (near death awareness)

Acts 7:54-60 Stephen saw "the glory of God and Jesus" before his death Note Jesus is standing – every other NT reference He is sitting at God's right hand Proves that a view to the other side is at least possible as God wills

We are always eager for information from life after death – Go to Bible first Too subjective to "prove" heaven or afterlife is true Know that God cares for the dying (Psalm 116:15)
