Leviticus 23:33-43

# The Key <u>Aspects</u> of Tabernacles

- 1. Living in booths—to commemorate <u>deliverance</u>
- 2. An unusual number of sacrifices (Num. 29:13-32)
- 3. The water drawing ceremony
- 4. The illumination of the temple

Suggestion #1: Establish <u>customs</u> that remind you and others of Jesus

## The Key Person of Tabernacles

- 1. Jesus "tabernacles" with us (John 1:14)
- 2. Jesus is the "Lamb of God" (John 1:36)
- 3. Jesus is the source of "Living Waters"

(John 7:2, 10-11, 37-41)

- 4. Jesus is the light of the world (John 8:12)
- 5. Jesus will <u>return</u> to live and rule <u>Israel</u>

(Rev. 7:9-17, Zech. 14:16)

Suggestion #2: Learn to see Jesus in everything

Conclusion: Don't let your love for Christ grow cold

# The Feasts-EXTRA

#### Christ as seen in the feasts of Israel:

- 1. Passover = Christ died for our sins.
- 2. Unleavened Bread = Christ is buried, His body being untouched by corruption.
- 3. Firstfruits = Christ rose from the dead, the firstfruits of them that sleep.
- 4. Pentecost = God has sent His Spirit who joins believing Jews and Gentiles in the church so that together they may enter the harvest fields.
- 5. Trumpets = The Jewish people are regathered from the four corners of the earth.
- 6. Atonement = the end time nation of Israel turns from their rejection of the Messiah and looks upon Him whom they have pierced.
- 7. Tabernacles = God the Son comes to the earth and establishes His kingdom in the land of promise.
