Matthew 6:24-33

God asks one thing of us in order to provide
for all of our needs

1. God's part– to provide for our needs

He wants you to put away worry
He wants you to consider His provision
He wants you to be different than unbelievers
He wants you to know He knows your needs

Key #1: Don't live to obtain security through the
accumulation of things

2. Your part– to seek Him

He expects you to seek His kingdom
He expects you to seek His righteousness
He expects you to seek Him first

Key #2: Strive to live in harmony with and purposely for
the kingdom of God

Worry Busters:

1. Commit Matthew 6:33 to memory and recall it to mind
whenever you are tempted to worry
2. In this verse David recounts God's record of faithful
provision:

*"I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the
righteous forsaken, Nor his descendants begging
bread." (Psalm 37:25)*

- Create a list of where you have experienced His
provision in your life
- Share your list with others in your life for mutual
encouragement

Seeking:

Daily ask yourself these questions:

- At the beginning of the day ask yourself if there is any-
thing you can do to bring yourself more into harmony
with His kingdom?
- At the end of the day ask yourself if there has been any
evidence that others can see that you have been living
for His purposes?

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
