4. What is the significance of all the items Hannah brought to the temple of The LORD (v. 24)?
5. Hannah dedicated Samuel unto The LORD. What aspect of your life do you need to dedicate/hand over to The LORD?

### Application-Life Principles

2. Recognize they belong to the Lord
3. Be Generous in giving
4. Be Careful in obedience
5. Worship together
