Application

1. Notice how Jesus withdrew to get alone with God to pray. Many times in our lives things clamor our attention & our bodies become exhausted after attending to all the demands of life. This being said, we must spend time alone with God to be strengthened by Him & know what He wills for our lives.

2. Let our prayer life reflect how Jesus communed with God. Meaning, Jesus always talked with God first before He made any major decisions.

3. Finding time to get alone with God is not easy, but prayer and getting into His Word is vital because it connects us to Him. Like Jesus, we must break away from others to get alone with God even if that means getting up early.

Getting Alone with God (Quiet Time)

- 1. Choose a time and place that will keep you free from interruption and distractions
- 2. Journal your thoughts when you interact with God's Word. Journaling helps Scripture take root in you and begins to transform your life! You will also be able to remember more of what the Lord is speaking to you about.
- 3. Start a new lifelong habit even though at times you may get discouraged because you may feel that this is difficult to do. Don't get up. This may take time to establish and you'll have to rearrange some of your priorities but spending time alone with God is worth it above everything else.

Things to do as your read

Mark your Bible as your read Put a question mark beside something you don't understand and then ask someone Put an arrow next to a Scripture that encourages you Ask who, what, where, when, where, and why

Journal

S.O.A.P.

"S" stands for **Scripture**: As your read pray what Scripture God wants to reveal or point out to you

"**O**" stands for **Observation**: What is taking place in the Scriptures? Who are the people? What's going on? What's happening?

"A" stands for **Application:** How can you take what you have read & apply it to your life right now? How will I be different today because I what I just read?

"P" stands for **Prayer**: Talk with God to help you with what you just read.

P - is there any PROMISE for me to claim?

E - is there any EXAMPLE for me to follow?

C - is there any COMMAND for me to obey?
