1. What insight, observation, or principal from this sermon did you find to be most helpful, insightful or troubling? Explain ...
2. Peter continues to appeal to scripture because he knows that is what they understand (v. 1424). Why is it important to start with where people are and show them God from what they already understand?
3. Based upon Peter's answer; in your own words how would you describe what it means to be a follower of Jesus?
 - From Peter's sermon, what facts are essential about Jesus for a non-believer to understand?
4. Do you find the act of repentance to be easy or difficult? Is it a onetime occurrence or a continual act?
5. It is not enough to read the words, or hear the sermons, we must put what we receive into practice. Share what the Holy Spirit is revealing to you through God's Word.
6. Described a time in your life where you have experienced or felt God's presence in a real way, personal to you?

Live it Out

- Just as the people asked, “What shall we do?” we need to ask the same question. It is not enough for us to be sorry for our sins but we must have a repented heart and ask God to forgive us. Then we must live like we’re forgiven! Maybe God is speaking to you through His Word or through someone else. Have you asked God, “what shall I do”?
- We can’t expect people to be someone they are not. We need to get to know people well enough to know how they need to hear the message of Jesus. Find a starting point to have a conversation with someone about Jesus this week
- Is there someone you really want for them to have a relationship with Christ? Share that name with other believers and pray that God would prepare their hearts to receive the truth about Christ’s life, death, and resurrection.
