Discuss

- 1. What insight, observation, or principal from this sermon did you find to be most helpful, insightful or troubling? Explain ...
- 2. Miracles rarely appear with a flashing sign saying, "Look here Miracle happening." If we don't share the news of what Jesus is doing in our lives, others may never know. How has He changed you? Has there been a miracle in your life?
- 3. Peter and John appear to cooperate fully with the governing authorities until they are asked to obey the Sanhedrin above God... it is here they draw the line. Despite living in an incredibly religiously free nation, where do you draw the line between culture and Christ?
- 4. Despite being witnesses to Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, the council continues to refuse to believe that Jesus is the Messiah. Have you ever changed your mind on a belief you held to be true? Why do you think they continued to be so stubborn?
- 5. To someone who has never known Christ, salvation can seem confusing. How would you describe "getting saved" to someone?
- 6. What in your life testifies the boldest about Jesus' work?
- 7. The Bible calls us to confess our sins, believe in the gospel and cooperate with the Holy Spirit so that God can work through us to glorify Himself and reach others. This is an ongoing process. Which area is the hardest for you?

Live it Out

Going beyond the things you can see with your eyes, ask God to show you how He is working in you and in those you love. When and if you are faced with something that changes your perspective, allow God to lead you and transform the way you think.

We all want God to perform big miracles in and around us, for believers and unbelievers alike. Share a big bold prayer with someone you trust and allow them to join you as you seek to witness the work of God.

Or, perhaps you are in a season where it seems your prayers are hindered, share this concern instead and allow God to reveal to you anything that may be obstructing His work in your life. (Psalm 139: 23-24: Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting).
