Breaking the Ice:

Think of and share a time in your life when someone came to your rescue.

Exploration:

Read: *Exodus 17:8-16, Deuteronomy 25:17-18*

Why did Israel have to respond to the attack of Amelek? What are some of the conflicts that we face that we didn't ask for?

Even though some were on the battlefield and some were on the top of the hill, how did each encourage the other? Think of some ways we can encourage others who are part of the battle.

Read: *Exodus 4:2-4, 17-20, 7:20, 14:16,*

The hands of Moses and the rod were to be raised- what did this symbol remind the warriors of Israel of?

How can we remind each other of the power of God that has been and is available to us?

Look again at Exodus 17:15- what does the name "The-Lord-Is-My-Banner" say about God's part on the team?

How would this truth help them in the future? How can it help you in the present?
