Definition:

- 1) prayer addressed to God
- 2) a place set apart or suited for the offering of prayer
 - 2a) a synagogue
 - 2b) a place in the open air where the Jews were went to pray,outside the cities, where they had no synagogue2b1) such places were situated upon the bank of a stream or theshore of a sea, where there was a supply of water for washing hands before prayer

Implications:

We should be regular and consistent in our praying There is benefit in "getting together" to pray There is benefit to having a regular place to pray.

Application:

We should assemble for the purpose of praying together not individuals praying in the same place.

There is strength and encouragement from being remembered in prayer.
