4. What societal trends, modern conveniences, and personal beliefs work against a Christian remaining in fellowship?
5. What are some the benefits of being in biblical fellowship as seen in Acts 2:42-47
6. What do you continually devote yourself to doing?
  - a. Do any of these activities help spread the message of Jesus?
7. What stuck out to you in this passage?
8. How will you respond (in action) in what was read and or discussed based on Acts 2:42-47?
