



## **Unshared Glory (Judges 7:1-8)**

### **Main Idea**

God's glory is not to be shared so let's make sure that we don't steal victory & credit due to Him who is deserving of our praise.

### **Ice Breaker:**

Recall a time when you "won" or were victorious despite the "odds" that were against you.

### **Discussion Questions**

1. Why did God want to reduce the size of Gideon's army?
2. If you were Gideon, how would you feel about God downsizing your army?
3. What was God trying to teach Gideon? You?
4. How does this passage relate to you in your life?
5. When has God used one of your weaknesses in your life to help someone else?
6. Where in your life do you feel that you're "outnumbered" & need an intervention from God?

### **Application**

Learn to trust God even when His methods for our obedience seems strange  
God uses our failures & limitations for His glory

### **Bottom Line**

*Like Gideon let us recognize the danger of fighting in our own strength (stealing God's glory).  
Know that we have victory in our battles when we give God the glory & not ourselves!*
