A Dose of Discernment Jude 10-16

To defend the faith you must be able to recognize error

1. Examine the <u>motives</u> of those who teach (vs. 10-11) Are they guided by self? - Cain

Are they greedy for <u>stuff</u>? - Balaam Are they greedy for <u>significance</u>? - Korah So: Stop and ask some questions

2. Look beyond the <u>appearance</u> of those who teach

(vs. 12-16)

Do they produce refreshment or <u>dryness</u>? - clouds Do they produce nourishment or <u>starvation</u>? - trees Do they produce guidance or <u>lostness</u>? - stars So: Don't take everything at <u>face value</u>

Conclusion:

A dose of discernment will offer great protection



FINDING FAITH'S FOUNDATION

- 1. If the teaching doesn't "seem right" watch out
- 2. If the teacher doesn't seem sincere watch out
- If there is a minimum amount of Bible and a maximum amount of conjecture - watch out
- 4. If there isn't a chapter and verse- watch out
- 5. If the teaching elevates man rather than God watch out
- 6. If there is a hidden meaning watch out
- If the teaching leans toward extreme freedom of behavior
 watch out
- 8. If the teaching leans toward extreme legalism in behavior
 - watch out
- 9. If the teaching mars the doctrine of Christ- watch out
