Mistake #2: Have a Hardened Heart Exodus 8:10, 10:1

Sequence

- 1. God predicts and promises hardening (7:1-7)
- 2. God demonstrates power (7:8-ff)

- 3. Pharaoh hardens his heart 8:15
 - 3. Lice, 4. Flies, 8:52 (hardens and reneges)
 - 5. Livestock, 9:7 "became hard"
 - 6. boils, 7. hail, 9:34-35 sinned more and hardened heart
- 4. God hardens Pharaoh's heart 10:1
 - 8. locusts 10:20 Lord hardened
 - 9. darkness 10:27 The Lord hardened
 - 10. Firstborn 11:10,
- 5. Pharaoh pursues Israel 14:4,8:17,

1. A hard heart defined

To knowledgably, willingly, and deliberately refuse to obey God.

2. A difficult question

Does Pharaoh or God harden the heart?

Suggestion: Pharaoh hardened, God proceeded to do the same? For sure: Both happened – maybe in the same space and time?

3. The causes of a hard-heart

Want to remain "right" Death before embarrassment Believe you can find a way to win against God

4. The cures for a hard heart

Best – Recognized God's authority, obey right away (humility)
Good - Allow God to convince you then obey (Teachable)
Bad - Allow to God to convince you without obeying (chastisement)
Really Bad – Don't allow God to convince you (judgment)
