 - What is the significance of this for Jesus? For you?
- 3. Have you ever felt forsaken by God? How did you recover the sense of the Lord's favor and presence?
- 4. Between verse 1-21 there is a back and forth between faith and despair. If there was a wall hanging of "despair" to your left and a wall hanging of "faith" on your right; where would you position yourself in the room to show where you are spiritually? Why? Explain.
- 5. Share how The LORD has provided for you this past week
 - If you have a need, how may this group help provide for your need?

• If you are going through some kind of suffering or trial, recount evidences of God's faithfulness to you in the past. What does that teach you about the Lord and what you can expect him to do for you?
